RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Providing RESIDENTIAL AND DAY SUPPORT SERVICES, since 1984, for adults and children with developmental disabilities and acquired brain injuries.

We design our residential and day programs around the unique needs and interests of each person we serve. Through home and community experiences, we enable individuals to develop critical skills:

- Self-care
- Communication
- Socialization
- Relationship-building
- Problem Solving
- Money Management
- Medication Management
- Health and Recreation

RESIDENTIAL SUPPORT MODELS

• Community Residence

Individuals (2-4 people) live in a private home in the community with Crotched Mountain staff providing 24-hour/7-day support.

• Individual Service Option (ISO)

The person served lives in the home of a “provider,” a local person or family contracted (not employed) by Crotched Mountain to provide needed support. Our role is to train and oversee the provider and the program.

• Companion Employee

The person served lives in his or her own home or apartment with a live-in companion (person or family) employed by Crotched Mountain to provide needed support.

• Apartment Setting

The person served lives in an apartment, either alone or with a housemate, and receives support from Crotched Mountain staff for a few hours each day, as needed.

• Cohousing

A group of individuals living together in a community of mutual support and caring. Each person has private space, while sharing amenities, such as a common kitchen where residents take turns cooking meals for the larger groups.

DAY SUPPORT SERVICES

• Day Habilitation

Based upon the individual’s personal interests, Crotched Mountain offers access to many vocational, job development and community activities such as volunteering, taking a class, or enjoying a recreational day trip. Services are offered Monday through Friday, usually for 6 hours each day.

• Family Support

We offer assistance in daily living to individuals and their families developed around their particular needs, including personal care, household chores, and transportation. Services are based both in and out of the family home and are offered Monday through Friday, usually for 8 hours each day.

From the South:

North (East) on Route 202 to Route 136 in Peterborough, East on Route 136 to Greenfield, and turn left onto Route 31 North. Turn right onto Crotched Mountain Road. Turn right onto Verney Drive. Follow signs for Main Entrance/Visitor Reception.

From the North:

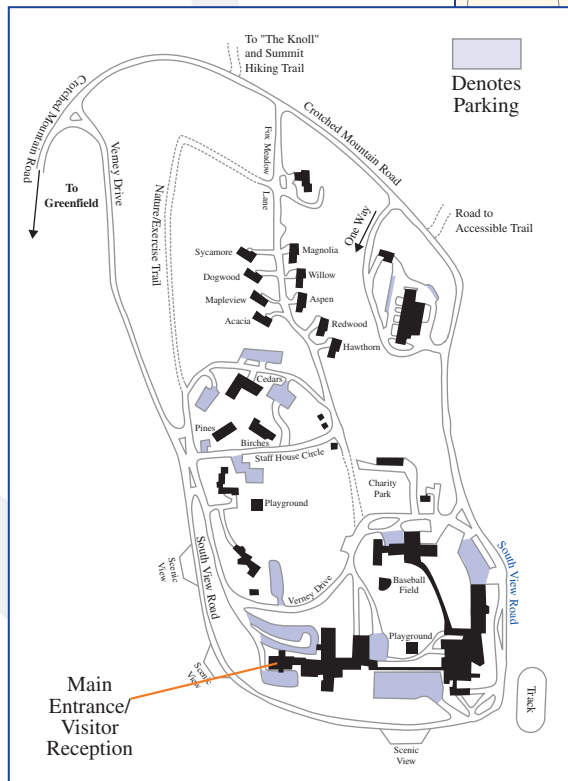
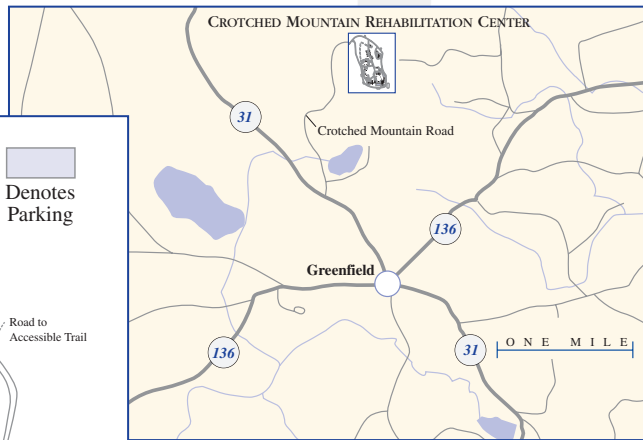
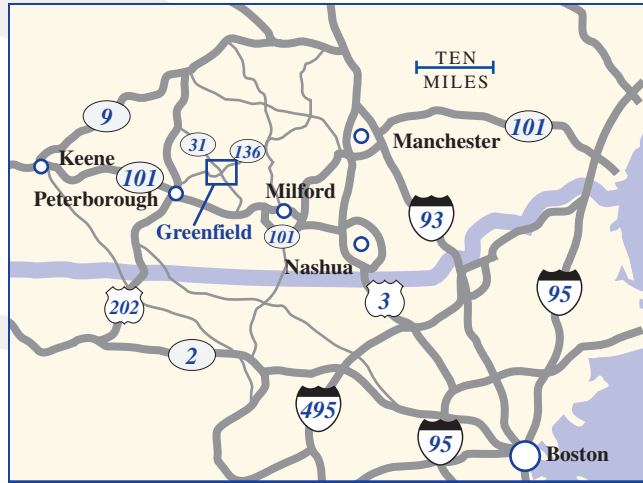
Take 93 South to Concord and merge onto 89 North. Bear left at Exit 5 onto Routes 202/9 West, towards Henniker/Keene. At Hillsborough, follow route 202 West towards Antrim/Peterborough. At Bennington, turn left onto Route 31 South into Greenfield. Turn left onto Crotched Mountain Road. Turn right onto Verney Drive. Follow signs for Main Entrance/Visitor Reception.

From the West:

Take 91 to Route 9 East. In Keene go straight onto Route 101 East. In Peterborough, take Route 202 East to Route 136 towards Greenfield. Take 136 into Greenfield and turn left onto Route 31 North. Turn right onto Crotched Mountain Road. Turn right onto Verney Drive. Follow signs for Main Entrance/Visitor Reception.

From the East:

Take Route 3 North to Exit 8 for Route 101-A West to Route 101 West. In Wilton turn right onto Route 31 North towards Greenfield. In Greenfield turn right onto Route 31 North. Turn right onto Crotched Mountain Road. Turn right onto Verney Drive. Follow signs for Main Entrance/Visitor Reception.
